Re: Important Update Regarding School Meal Prices

We hope this letter finds you well. We want to inform you about an important change regarding the price of school meals. From the start of the next academic year (September 2023), all schools in the Shireland Collegiate Academy Trust will see the price of school meals increase from £2.40 to £2.60 per meal deal; we will also see prices increase for individually sold items too. Please be aware that this increase in price does not impact our students that receive free school meals.

In the current financial climate, we know that any increase in costs are concerning and we want to assure you that this decision was not taken lightly. Despite several schools in the region increasing their meal prices beyond this threshold, we managed to maintain the price of £2.40 for the current academic year. After careful consideration and evaluation of our meal program, it became evident that the current price of £2.40 was no longer sustainable to meet the rising costs of food, ingredients, and operational expenses.

On a more positive note, this price adjustment has meant that we have been able to revamp our meal deal to ensure that your child has greater flexibility and a wider variety of options. With the new pricing structure, your child will be able to select any hot meal, dessert item, and drink for £2.60. This change is designed to provide greater variety and options for your child while maintaining the affordability of our meal program. We believe it is essential for our students to have a balanced and nutritious meal, and we are committed to offering them a range of choices to suit their individual tastes and dietary needs.
