<b>Art and Design</b>	Practical work - Annotations to be amended and individual homework tasks to be completed.
<b>Biology</b>	Biology paper 1 - Chapter 1 - Cells Revision guide - Pg 16 – 26. Read, produce a series of notes, mind maps or flash card. If you have already produced a revision resource on this chapter, go over them and test yourself.
<b>Business</b>	Recapping HR content covered so far (before the summer) key terms that we associate with HR especially organisational structures.
<b>Chemistry</b>	Chemistry paper 1 - Chapter 1 – Atomic Structure Revision guide - Pg 16 – 28 Read, produce a series of notes, mind maps or flash card. If you have already produced a revision resource on this chapter, go over them and test yourself.

<b>English Literature</b>	Macbeth: Read Act 1 Scene 1 and Act 1 Scene 2 create a character profile that you can later add to on the focusing on the Witches and the audiences first impressions of Macbeth.
