Subject	Details of Revision Task
Art and Design	Pupils need to develop their ideas and present work from this week from their weekly plan which they have made. Chemistry	Chemistry paper 1 - Chapter 2 Revision guide: Pg 54 – 61. Read, produce a series of notes, mind maps or flash card. If you have already produced a revision resource on this chapter, go over them and test yourself. OR Seneca assignment covering the same material.
Combined Science Trilogy	Chemistry paper 1 - Chapter 2 HT revision guide - Pg 202-221 FT revision guide - Pg 190-208 Read, produce a series of notes, mind maps or flash card. If you have already produced a revision resource on this chapter, go over them and test yourself. OR Seneca assignment covering the same material.
DT	Impact of forces and stresses (joints) pages 73 - 74 revision guide.
English Literature	Using your anthologies: Create detailed revision cards or a mind map on the following poems: Remains, Bayonet Charge, The Charge of the Light Brigade and Exposure. Include a minimum of 5 key quotes and key contextual information.
Geography	1. Read pages 42-44 of the revision guide. Make a mind map of key information. Include: where rainforests are located, layers of the rainforest, causes of deforestation in Malaysia and impacts of deforestation in Malaysia.

German	Pages 22-24 in workbooks.
Health and Social Care	Using your HSC revision guide. Read the information on pages 12-17, then complete the forms quiz to test your knowledge and understanding.
History	Use the My Revision Notes: Medicine in Britain Revision Guide. Complete all revision in your revision exercise book. DO NOT write in the revision guide. Read the information on pages 14 and 15. Complete the 'Organising Knowledge' task from the orange box on page 15. Draw a table and write the similarities and differences between the Black Death and Great Plague. Read the exam answer in the 'You're the examiner' box on page 15. Mark the answer, then re-write it to improve it in your exercise book.
Maths	Sparx consolidation/ mixed topic questions attached to Sparx Homework.
GCSE PE	Seneca tasks set online. Revision of heart function and breathing.
Physics	Physics paper 1 - Chapter 2 Revision guide – Pg 52-62 Read, produce a series of notes, mind maps or flash card. If you have already produced a revision resource on this chapter, go over them and test yourself. OR Seneca assignment covering the same material.
Religious Studies	Use the Aqa GCSE revision guide provided to complete your revision tasks. All revision tasks are to be completed in Revision exercise books. TASK - Read page 18 (Christianity 1.5 The incarnation and Jesus, the Son of God). Read the page of information and then complete APPLY Task A at the bottom of the page (5 mark question). TASK - read through page 51 (Sikhism - 3.4 Karma, rebirth and Mukti). Read the page and then write down your own definitions for the following key words: Karma, rebirth and Mukti. Then, draw out a diagram to represent Sikh beliefs in re-incarnation.
