Arbor Parent Portal and App

We are now on 86% of parents and carers who have signed up to Arbor. If you sign up to Arbor we can communicate with you more easily via the app messaging system. It is free for us to message you in this way, whereas it costs around £50 for each whole school text that we send. Emails are free to send, but we would very much prefer to use the in-app message system as it is more convenient for you. You can also contact the school using the in-app message facility.

What can you see in Arbor?

- You can view homework assignments that are set on Arbor and monitor the completion rate of your child's homework.
- School trips and clubs will be organised through Arbor.
- You can view academic reports, attendance and behaviour for your child.
- You can give consent for different areas, and update your contact details straight through the app.
- Soon, Arbor will replace Parent Pay for payment for lunches, trips etc.


Arbor Student Portal and App

Arbor has recently developed an app for students to use. Students will be emailed with details on how to download and log in to the app. This is something they can have on their phone to use outside of school, as phones are not permitted in school (unless they are switched off and in bags). They will be able to access their timetable, homework assignments and more using the app. This has been launched with students already but you can visit this link for information regarding the new Arbor Student App.

Y11 Mock Examinations

The second set of mock exams for Year 11 on Monday 24th February. They will last for just over two weeks and the overall timetable can be seen on the next below. Morning exams begin at 9am sharp and afternoon exams at 1:30pm. Students must be seated and the exam regulations read out before the exam can start so it is important that they arrive at 8:40am each day.

Y9 Options Deadline

Year 9 students were given a paper copy of the Options form before the holiday. In the next few weeks they will complete a Careers theme in L4L that will support them with their choices. They should hand in their options form to their form teacher at the end of the theme, on Friday 7th March.

Places on courses are not allocated on a first come, first served basis so handing the form in early does not give an advantage. The most important thing is that students carefully consider which courses will suit them best for their future pathways.

Y10 Work Experience: Monday 30th June - Friday 4th July 2025

A reminder that Year 10 students should be looking for a work experience placement. The deadline for finding a placement and handing in the form to Mrs Evans (was Miss Adams) is Friday 11 April 2025. New forms can be collected from main reception or can be downloaded from the WBCA website.

Uniform

Please ensure that any uniform issues are corrected before term begins. Details of our uniform can be found on our website.

Key points to note:

- Blazers must be worn at all times. Jumpers are optional, blazers are compulsory.
- Trainers are not allowed shoes must be smart, leather type and polishable.
- Hoodies and tracksuit tops are not allowed.
- The only jewellery permitted is one stud per ear, one nose stud. Other jewellery must be removed.

Our policy is that if a child is without correct uniform, including footwear, for any reason, we will provide them with school items to borrow, and we will work with you to put it right as soon as possible.
